OPENING TIPS:

- The Grand Valley State Lakers stormed through the top three seeds of the GLIAC to claim their first tournament title since 2008, knocking off the top-seeded Davenport Panthers, 80-70, on Sunday. It was the seventh GLIAC Tournament title in program history and the third under head coach Ric Wesley.
- The Lakers have won seven of their last eight games, holding their opponent to 70 points or fewer in all eight contests... The Lakers are 15-2 this season when their opponent scores 70 points or less.
- The Lakers are looking for their first 20-win season since 2009-10, when they went 22-9 and received an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament. This is the 11th time GVSU has reached the NCAA Tournament, going 9-11 all-time.
- This is the 15th all-time meeting between the Lakers and Flyers and the first since 2006... Lewis leads the all-time series, 8-6, but the Lakers have won the last three meetings and four of the last five... This is the first time the two have faced off in post-season competition.

GVSU closed the GLIAC Championship on an 11-0 run to stun the top-seeded Davenport Panthers on their home floor for the team's first league title since 2008. The Lakers overcame a nine-point, second-half deficit (50-41) to storm back for the upset win.

News and Notes

ALL-GLIAC HONOREES

The Lakers had three All-Conference performers honored Friday night at the tournament banquet: **HUNTER HALE** earned first team All-GLIAC, **JAKE VAN TUBBERGEN** was named second team All-GLIAC and **ISAIAH BROCK** is part of the All-Defensive team. This is the second straight year with all-conference honors for both Hale and Van Tubbergen.

HALE STORM

Hunter Hale is the GLIAC leader in made threes (86)... His total is the fourth most in a single season in program history... He is eight away from the all-time record of 94, set by Jason Jamerson in the 2007-08 season, the last time GVSU won the GLIAC Tournament.

BROCK PARTY

The numbers prove that Isaiah Brock has had somewhat of a defensive impact since joining the Lakers this season but, outside of his 55 blocks, they don't tell the whole story... His ability to alter shots, and opponents, has been massive for the Lakers both defensively and on the boards this season...

HISTORY MADE

The Lakers are the first-ever seven-seed to win the GLIAC Tournament and they are the lowest seed ever to win it... Twice a 6-seed has cut down the nets, but never lower than that until last weekend.

TALKING TRANSFERS

The Lakers brought in several exciting transfers for the 2018-19 season including Division I Jeremiah Ferguson (Youngstown State), Isaiah Brock (Oakland) and Chris Gilbert (Oakland)... Demitrius Lake (Schoolcraft CC) comes in after a dominant high school career in West Michigan...

WESLEY'S WINNING WAYS

Laker head coach **RIC WESLEY** enters his 15th season as the head coach of the Lakers... He has reached the GLIAC Tournament in 13 of his first 14 seasons and has led the Lakers to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including two Elite Eights... Wesley's 304 victories are second most in program history while his career .689 winning percentage is the best ever by a Lakers coach with more than one season in Allendale...
